## **Wilderness Medicine Courses Fact Sheet**

### **CPR with AED (\$40)**

ASHI CPR and AED is a combined CPR and AED program designed specifically for laypeople. The program is an excellent choice for both the community and workplace setting, and is based upon the 2015 International Consensus on Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and Emergency Cardiovascular care (ECC) Science with Treatment Recommendations (COSTR) and other evidence-based treatment recommendations. This is generally a two to four hour course, depending on the number of students.

### **CPR PRO for the Professional Rescuer (\$95)**

Students learn how to recognize a life-threatening emergency, how to provide basic life support and what to do in case of an airway obstruction or choking. ASHI's CPR PRO for the professional rescuer has been approved for training for emergency medical services personnel and is accepted by the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT). This is generally a four-hour course, depending on the number of students.

### **Basic First Aid (\$40)**

ASHI Basic First Aid was created to help students develop basic first aid knowledge, skills, and the confidence to respond. The program is an excellent choice for both the community and workplace setting, and is consistent with recommendations of the 2015 National First Aid Science Advisory Board and OSHA's Best Practices for First Aid Training Programs in the Workplace. This is generally a two to four-hour course, depending on the number of students.

### **Emergency Oxygen Provider (\$30)**

Serious and life-threatening medical emergencies often cause oxygen to be depleted in the body leaving the victim at risk for shock. The ASHI Emergency Oxygen program focuses on administering emergency oxygen to breathing and non-breathing persons, emergency oxygen delivery systems, and integrating pulse oximetry. This is generally a two-hour course, depending on the number of students.

### **Advanced First Aid (\$190)**

ASHI Advanced First Aid is designed for the person who needs or desires more first aid training than basic first aid, but not to the level of Emergency Medical Response. Perfect for corporate emergency response teams, this 17-21 hour course presents many of the most common illnesses and injuries responders are likely to encounter. This is generally a two to three day course, depending on the number of students.

### **Emergency Medical Response (\$480)**

ASHI Emergency Medical Response is designed to provide non-ems responders including government, corporate, law enforcement, and corrections personnel with a level of training comparable to a professional emergency medical responder. This 48-hour course is consistent with National EMS Curriculum requirements and education standards; however, it is not the intent of the ASHI Emergency Medical Response program to cross the EMS scope of practice threshold. This is generally a six-day course, depending on the number of students.

### **Basic Wilderness First Aid (\$95)**

Basic Wilderness First Aid is an intensive 8- to 10-hour course for those who are involved in wilderness recreation. This course may also meet the needs of volunteers and professionals who lead groups on short trips in relatively low-risk situation.

### **Wilderness First Aid (\$190)**

Wilderness First Aid is a 16- to 20-hour course for those who are involved in serious wilderness activities. This course is the choice of many wilderness trip leaders and guides.

### **Wilderness First Responder (\$720)**

Wilderness First Responder is a 60- to 80-hour course for wilderness professionals and others who want a higher level of training or require WFR certification.

### **Wilderness EMT Upgrade (\$390)**

Wilderness EMT Upgrade is a 40-hour course for those who are already certified as EMTs. The course builds on EMT training and adds wilderness concepts and skills with many role-playing scenarios.

### **ASHI CPR/1<sup>st</sup> Aid Instructor (\$825)**

The ASHI Instructor Development Course is the first step in being able to teach all of ASHI's courses. This course is 16 hours and includes all instructor materials and certification registration. The prerequisite is current CPR and 1<sup>st</sup> aid certification.
